ORDER

The court finds that the above named defendant qualifies for court supervision pursuant to 730 ILCS 5/5-6-1(c)(1),(2), and (3). Adjudication of guilt is deferred. The defendant is placed on court supervision for a period of:

- 90 days _____, with the following terms:
- 1. The defendant shall not violate any law of any jurisdiction, including any traffic laws.
- 2. The defendant shall immediately pay to the Circuit Clerk:

- 3. The defendant must attend and successfully complete a traffic safety program approved by the Court at the defendant's own cost and file a certificate of successful completion 10 days before the termination date of this supervision order.

If the certificate has not been filed, then with or without the defendant's presence, the Court may have authority to summarily revoke court supervision and enter a conviction.
