



## What is an Election Judge . . .

They are the officials that serve the voters in the polling places, administer election procedures, and ensure that the rights of voters are protected on Election Day.

## Duties of an Election Judge . . .

- Adhere to the rules & regulations of the Christian County Clerk's Office and the State of Illinois Election Code
- Operate voting equipment
- Distribute correct ballots to voters
- Ability to work the entirety of Election Day

## Desired Qualifications . . .

- Remain impartial and not exert influence over voters
- Communicate clearly with voters
- Attention to detail
- Comfortable with assisting and serving a diverse population

## Serving as an Election Judge . . .

**WHEN** —on Election Day (from approximately 5:00 A.M. until polls close at 7:00 P.M. and the paperwork is completed)

**WHERE** —when possible, in the precinct where you live or elsewhere in Christian County

Election judges earn \$200.00.
