What is an Election Judge . . .

They are the officials that serve the voters in the polling places, administer election procedures, and ensure that the rights of voters are protected on Election Day.

Duties of an Election Judge . . .

- Adhere to the rules & regulations of the Christian County Clerk's Office and the State of Illinois Election Code
- Operate voting equipment
- Distribute correct ballots to voters
- Ability to work the entirety of Election Day

Desired Qualifications . . .

- Remain impartial and not exert influence over voters
- Communicate clearly with voters
- Attention to detail
- Comfortable with assisting and serving a diverse population

Serving as an Election Judge . . .

WHEN —on Election Day (from approximately 5:00 A.M. until polls close at 7:00 P.M. and the paperwork is completed)
WHERE —when possible, in the precinct where you live or elsewhere in Christian County
